Wakeland Band Financial Aid Services

All those seeking financial aid must qualify by going through the steps listed below in order to be considered for financial aid. While there are limited funds available, the Wakeland High School Band Booster Association understands there are needs and wants to help to the extent that funding allows.

Financial Need: This can be based on proof of participation in the free or reduced lunch program through Frisco ISD, or alternatively through a tax return with your stated income from the last 12 months filing.

Academic Performance: Your student must be Academically Eligible to participate in band in order to qualify for funding – Parent to provide a copy of the student's last report card from the prior semester or a current progress report that depicts eligibility.

Personal Essay: The student should submit a one page essay on the importance of Band, what they hope to achieve, and why it is important for them to be a part of the program.

Parental Essay: Parents should submit a paragraph or two highlighting the importance of their child's participation and their understanding of the benefits of the band program.

Completing these steps does not, in any way, mean to indicate that funding will be made available, as they are considered entrance criteria into the evaluation process. You will be contacted by a Band Booster Association representative following your submissions. Submissions may be sent to the Booster Vice President for review and submittal to the financial aid subcommittee. You will be contacted once funding is approved and available.
